In the New Covenant, Jesus achieves everything sinners need for redemption. His death saves them from wrath, purchases their regeneration, justification, adoption, and their perseverance in the faith. Because Jesus is the mediator of the covenant of Grace, there is no work for the person to do, to earn these blessings. That is why the Covenant of Grace is a covenant of promise, not a covenant of law. "Believe upon Jesus, and you will receive all the blessings Jesus earned", that is the New Covenant of Grace.


