Matthew 28:19

Read from a child-friendly version. Ask children to read as appropriate, respective to age. Briefly explain the meaning of the verse. If you need help, here is our summary:

Christians are baptised in the name of our God! So Jesus spoke of one name, not three names, because there is one God. But three persons share the name "God", or "Yahweh". These three persons are shown to us in the Bible as equal in power, wisdom, goodness and love. And their names are God the Father, God the Son (Jesus), and God the Holy Spirit. We call this truth, "The Trinity".

Psalm Reading

Psalms 38

Read from a child-friendly version. Ask children to read as appropriate, respective to age. Briefly explain the meaning of the Psalm. If you need help, here is our summary:

The Psalms remind us that difficulties are very common in life, and that God wants us to pray about them. David is suffering in his life for two reasons. One is because of his own sin which has terrible consequences (vs1-10), such as feeling guilty, and being disciplined by God. The second is other people's sins (vs11-20). David prays to God for forgiveness and help in vs 18, 21, and 22. What things do you need to confess to God? Have you trusted that Jesus died for your sin? What things do you need God's help with?



Mark 12:1-12

Read from a child-friendly version. Ask children to read as appropriate, respective to age. Briefly explain the meaning of the passage. If you need help, here is our summary:

The parable Jesus tells, shows us the history of the Israelites. God gave them the promised land, but they killed God's prophets who were sent to teach them. We learn that receiving gifts from God (which is called grace), brings responsibility to obey Him. Has God's gracious gifts to you, caused you to become obedient from your heart? Are you bearing fruit for him? What does Jesus want your life to be like, in response to his sacrifice for you?

Psalm Reading

Psalms 40

Read from a child-friendly version. Ask children to read as appropriate, respective to age. Briefly explain the meaning of the psalm. If you need help, here is our summary:

When God helps in a hard situation, and heals someone, or gives us peace, or saves our soul, or rescues us from our enemies, he wants us to praise Him and thank Him! God is our helper and our rescuer! He is worthy of all our praise. Because he is so gracious, we don't need to be perfect; that is why God wants a loving and humble heart, more than sacrifices and offerings (vs 6-8). When we trust Jesus, love God, and desire to serve Him, God is delighted in us, even if we are not perfect.

Read from a child-friendly version. Ask children to read as appropriate, respective to age. Briefly explain the meaning of the passage. If you need help, here is our summary:

When the Jewish Christians were spread out from Jerusalem because of persecution, James wrote to them to strengthen them. He taught them that troubles and persecution are not outside of God's plan, they ARE God's plan to make us stronger in our faith! When we are in trials, we can pray to God for wisdom so that we can make the right decisions.

ADDITIONAL READING & DISCIPLESHIP

CATECHISM REFERENCE - 1 Peter 1:2

Peter says that our salvation is the work of the Trinity. The Father chose us before time, The Spirit joins us to Jesus and makes us holy, and Jesus is our Lord whom we serve and obey. The Trinity is one of the most important truths of Scripture. We should always remember, they are three persons, and are one God, not three parts of one God. They aren't a third each, but each fully God. Do you have questions about how we should relate to each person in God?

CATECHISM REFERENCE - 2 Corinthians 13-14

Paul mentions each person of the Trinity, because they each carry out certain parts of our salvation, though they work together. We are all dependent on the grace of Jesus for salvation. We all depend on the love of God the Father sent Jesus to die for our sins. Lastly, we need the fellowship of the Holy Spirit; we all receive the Holy Spirit when we trust in Jesus and He keeps us all united as brothers and sisters in Christ.
