*Many people believe in false gods. But there is only one, true, living God. Our God is the only Creator of the world, the only One who judges our souls when we die, and the One who saves us from our sins. Moses taught Israel to remember this, so that they didn't believe in, or worship, other gods who could not save them or help them.*

## Psalm Reading

Psalms 25

Read from a child-friendly version. Ask children to read as appropriate, respective to age. Briefly explain the meaning of the Psalm. If you need help, here is our summary:

*This Psalm is a prayer to God for help when David was in trouble. He begins by remembering who God is (vs1-3). Then he prays for help in two ways (vs4-7): firstly for help in his situation, and secondly for help against his sin. In vs 16-18, David acknowledges that his enemies are causing him pain, but that he is not perfect either. Like David, we can call on God to graciously help us, but not because we deserve it. We must especially pray to God for forgiveness through the blood of Jesus.*

*This Psalm is all about trusting God's promises. God promises to save us from our enemies through Jesus, if we trust Him! What enemies does he save us from? (Eg. sin, death, judgment, Satan). He even promises to listen when we ask for help in other problems too (bullies, poverty, confusion, fear), but we know sometimes He doesn't always say yes. Like vs13-14, we trust God and wait for His answer.*

## Sermon Reading

Ephesians 2:4-6

Read from a child-friendly version. Ask children to read as appropriate, respective to age. Briefly explain the meaning of the passage. If you need help, here is our summary:

*When God saves us, he makes us a new person, with a new heart! We might think that He waits for us to choose Him, and then He gives us a new heart. But the Bible really teaches that God comes to us while we are dead in our hearts, and makes us alive, with new hearts and gives us faith to believe. Then we trust in Jesus and are forgiven. God is the rescuer, and we are just the people being rescued. We don't help God save us!*

**CATECHISM REFERENCE** - Isaiah 45:18

*There are no other gods. God did not ask for help to create the world, and he didn't make any other gods. He made angels, who became sinful, and pretend to be gods - but they are really demons (1 Cor 10:20). Everybody is made by God, and so should give Him glory.*

**CATECHISM REFERENCE** 1 Timothy 2:5

*If there were many gods, there could be many ways to forgiveness, and many religions could be true. But since only our God exists, only His way of forgiveness (Jesus) can lead to salvation. And only Christianity is the true religion. Jesus is our only way to God, because the Father only sent him to die for our sins.*
