Here we see that the persons are separate and different from each other. But we can also see that they are united, both by the Holy Spirit resting on Jesus' shoulder as well as the Father's recognition of Jesus.*

*This Psalm teaches us some important things about living. The Psalm first shows how righteous people avoid doing wicked and sinful things, they even ignore the advice of the wicked (vs 1). Instead, righteous people love the Lord and obey His word (vs 2). This Psalm also shows us how those who trust are planted on a strong foundation, but those who hate God are not and will be judged (vs 3-6).*

## Psalm Reading

Psalms 3

Read from a child-friendly version. Ask children to read as appropriate, respective to age. Briefly explain the meaning of the psalm. If you need help, here is our summary:

*This Psalm was written by David when he was on the run from his son, Absalom. David starts by introducing his situation to God as being pretty bad (vs 1-2). He then declares his confidence in God's sovereignty and Providence despite David's bad circumstance (vs 3-6). He finishes by asking God to deliver him from the people chasing him(vs 7-8). This Psalm shows us that even though life gets hard, God is still sovereign and we can always trust and find rest in Him. This Psalm also teaches that it is up to God alone to judge the wicked and save the righteous.*

*Jesus is our Good Shepherd. For everyone who has faith in Jesus, Jesus has paid for their sins, gives them eternal life, and looks after them for their whole life. Because Jesus is looking after us, we will never suffer so much, struggle so much, or sin so much, that God will kick us out of His family. If we are truly saved by Jesus, we can never stop being saved, because our spiritual safety depends on Jesus' promises, not on our obedience.*
