God's grace is indeed immeasurable. Though we are all sinners, He has made a way for us to be reconciled to Him and completely forgiven for our sins. God sent His son to die for our sin on the cross we deserve. But just because God has made a way for salvation doesn't mean everyone will be saved. People who reject Jesus are still lost in their sins. In today's verse, Paul explains that people who don't believe are still going to Hell when they die. In fact, rejecting Jesus is another horrible sin. Have you repented of your sin and believed in Jesus?

The Psalm is about being confident in the Lord no matter what happens. Verse 1 teaches us that since God is mighty we can trust in Him. And confidence mustn't end when things get tough either. Even when life seems hard, we can keep trusting in God who never changes (Vs 2-3). Moreover, we should be confident in worshipping God, never being too shy to bring things to God in prayer (Vs 4-12). Never forget that God is faithful and that we can always trust in Him no matter what happens!

The people laughed at the idea of Jesus being a King - but dying is how Jesus would become the King!

CATECHISM REFERENCE - John 5:28-29

It's true that God is a loving God. He cares for us and sustains us, He graciously holds everything together and even provides sinners the necessities they need to live. But there is still a day coming when God will judge both sinners and saints. Those who trust Jesus and live righteously will be judged worthy of eternal life. But those who hate God and reject Jesus will be judged unrighteous and sent to Hell forever. We must make sure that we cling to Jesus and live consistently with our faith in Jesus, making sure to preach the gospel to all.

CATECHISM REFERENCE - Hebrews 2:3

The salvation that God offers in Jesus is truly the only way to be saved. This gospel is free to all who hear it but if it is rejected, there is no other way to God. If someone dies without believing in Jesus, they go to Hell forever, that's it, no exceptions. So then, we must be sure to never reject the good news of the gospel. Cling to Jesus! And never stop clinging!
