Sermon Reading

James 3:1-12

Read from a child-friendly version. Ask children to read as appropriate, respective to age. Briefly explain the meaning of the passage. If you need help, here is our summary:

As Christian, we all continue to struggle with sin in some way. This might mean different things for different people but nonetheless the biggest struggle we all face is controlling our mouths. James gives us a number illustrations to help us understand this danger; first is a horse's bridle, second is a ship's rudder, and third is a small fire that sets a whole forest alight. These three examples show as the power of this tiny part of our bodies; it has the power to maim or to heal, to destroy or to create. We must then be vigilant in watching what leaves our mouths as it is that which can defile us (see also Matt 15:11, Mark 7:20).
